



EXPLORER GUESS WHO

Follow the directions in the Unit Study to create your Guess Who Game Board.

Print out two copies of the following pages so that each player can have their own set of cards.

How to Play:

1. Players determine who goes first by playing one round of rock, paper, scissors.
2. Player One will use the information on their Explorer Cards to ask a yes or no question to Player Two, in order to determine Player Two's Mystery Explorer.
3. Example questions are: *Did your Explorer originate in Italy? Did your Explorer travel to Africa? Did your Explorer travel by ship?* (Younger children may ask more concrete questions like, *Is your Explorer wearing a hat?*)
4. As both players go back-and-forth answering questions, they will use deductive reasoning to remove cards that do not fit the description of their opponent's Mystery Explorer until they can guess who it is.
5. The first player to guess correctly wins!

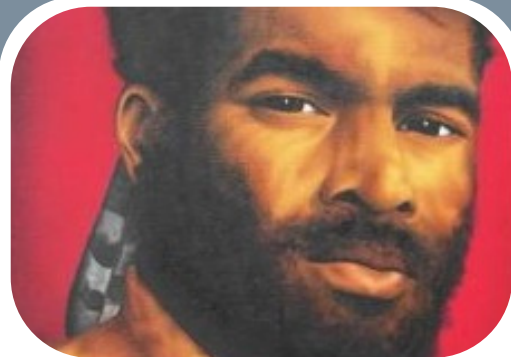

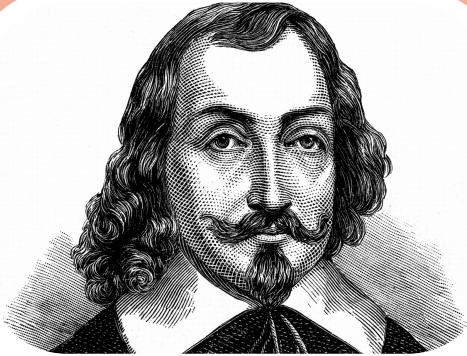

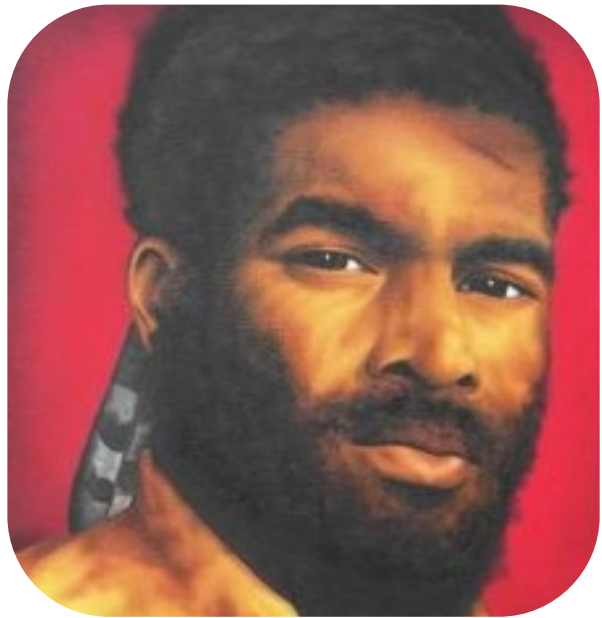
