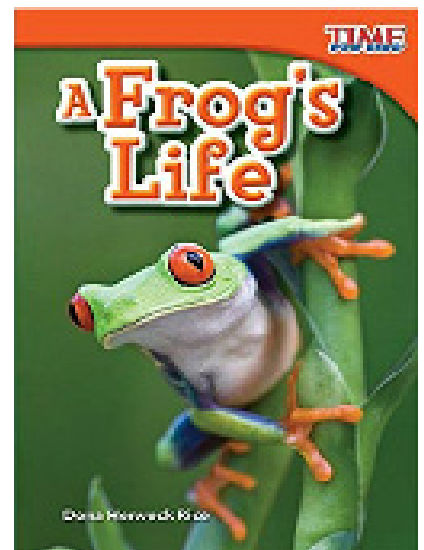
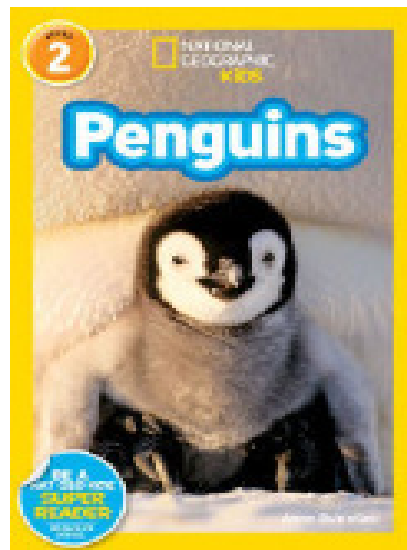
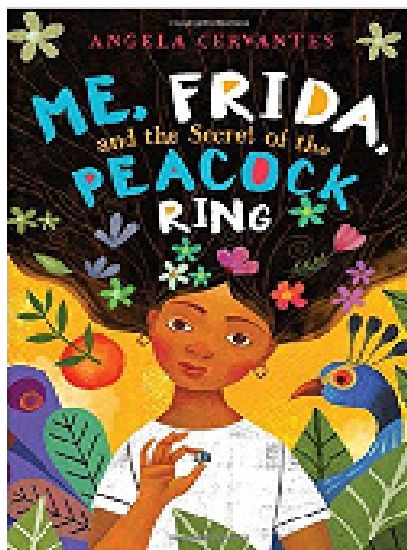
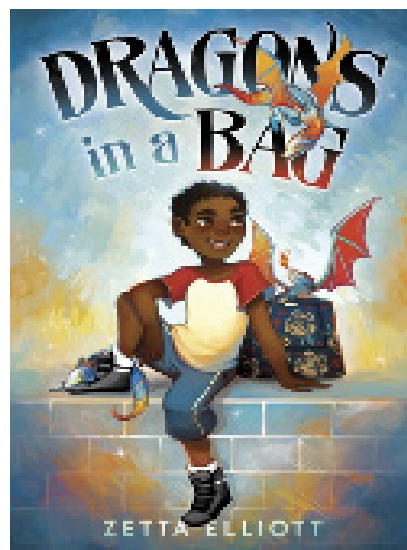
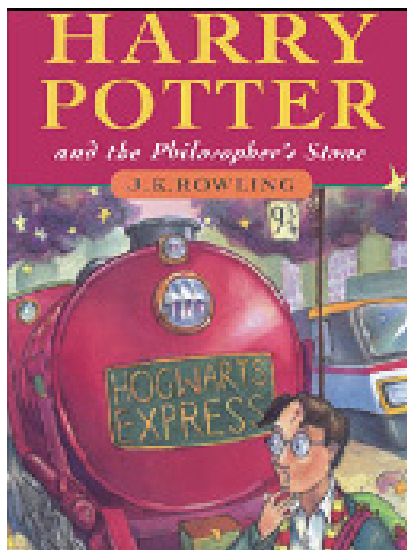
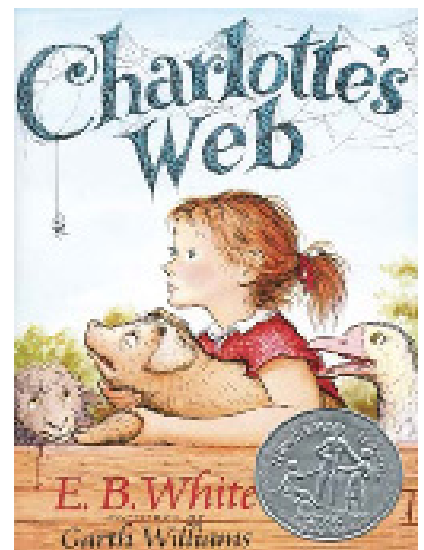
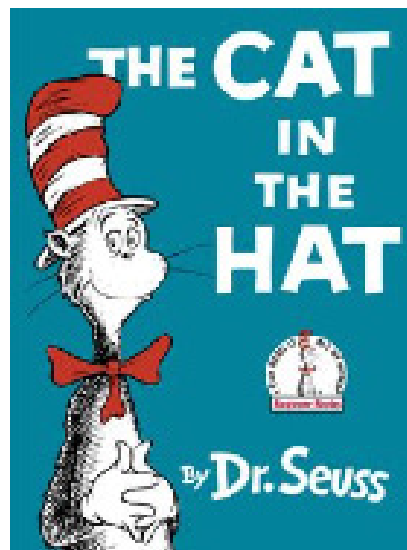
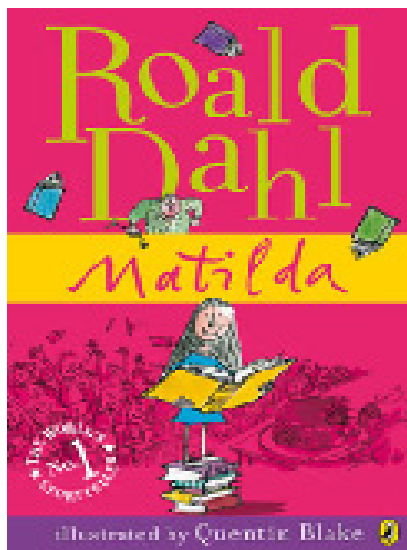
Materials:
